Our Challenges:

- The Academic Period 2021-2022 falls partly in the Pandemic Period and this created severe disruption in the Teaching-Learning Process. So, to continue the Teaching-Learning Process and cater knowledge to each and every student was a big challenge during that period. Offline classes started from November 2021 and were disrupted once again on January 2022.
- We continued the Teaching-Learning Process through online modes using some video-conferencing platforms but those processes are never equivalent to the Direct-Teaching in Classrooms during that period. To organize the Practical Classes of the Science Departments through online modes was also a serious challenge for the Institution.
- Due to prolonged physical absence in the college, because of pandemic, a section of the student community lost their motivation of learning. So, it was a serious challenge to the teachers of the college to motivate and tune them properly towards education.
- Renovation of the Chemistry and Physics Laboratories of the college was in progress. So, it was a challenge for the College-Administration to complete the work properly in this period.
- All the washrooms in the college need to go through thorough renovation. College -Authority took this issue seriously.
- Lack of proper students Common-Rooms is also an important concern to the College-Authority.

Our Future Plans:

- College has a plan to increase its efficiency towards smooth organization of both Theory and Practical classes in offline modes after prolong session of online classes during pandemic period.
- College has a plan to organize Students-Mentoring classes periodically in a scheduled Routine-Structure in order to meet up the academic deficiencies of the students and also motivate them towards Education and suitable Career Advancement.
- College has a plan to complete the renovation work of the Heritage Building.
- College has a plan to introduce dedicated classes to promote co-curricular activities of the students.

- College has a plan to establish a Student-Canteen inside the newly constructed Gurudeb Bhawan Campus.
- College has started the work for the construction of Girls' Common Room.
- College has a plan to set up MoUs and linkages with other Higher Educational Institutions to enhance the Research Activities and also to organize Field-Based Activities for both the students and teachers of the college.
